A Tract of Land in y^e Libertys and bounds of Philadelphia, (which was formerly Laid out unto Thomas fairman) Beginning at a Corn^r white oak in Shakamaxunch Line, thence N.E. by a line of trees 160 p^{ches} to Franckford Creek thence down the Severall Courses thereof to a corner tree Standing near y^e same thence w.s.w by a line of trees 180 p^{ches} to y^e place of beginning Containing 40 acres of Land which is accordingly Entred and Record^d in y^e Survey^r Generalls office at Philadelphia
