

These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Richard Moore the said number of two hundred and forty five Acres of Land in the place aforesaid and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy hereof to be delvd. to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad'l'a the 28<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>mo</sup>. 1701.
