Surveyed for Mary More as the assignee of Thomas Brigs 250 acres of Land lying in the fork of Upland Creek begining at a marked red oak standing by the sd creek side and from thence running up the sd creek on several courses to a marked post standing by the sd creek and also in the line of the township of Concord and from thence along the sd Concord line 66^{perch} ^{NNW} to a marked oak being a marked corner tree of Thomas Brasey and from thence along the sd Braseys line of marked trees N. E. b E. 190 ^{perch}. to a marked post being a corner mark of Gilbert Woellams land and from thence along the sd Woellams line of marked trees S. E. b S. 210 ^{perch}. to a marked post and from thence SWB W 180 ^{perch}. to the first menchened red oak.
