Layd out for thomas merser 100 Acres of Land Laying one the west side of Upland Creek begining at a marked black oke standing by the Creek sid from thence Runing w.s.w. in to the woods by William Woodmonsey's Line of marked trees 126 Perches to a marked white oke from thence N.W. 140 Perches to A marked gum thence ene. to the Creek side to a maple tree. 150 Perches and doune the Creek one severall Courses to the first marked tree.
