

Several other considerable quantities of land in the said place now possessed

by Richd Thomas one of the Welch Purchers or his Assigns and whereas, <sup>by</sup> the

said Nath<sup>l</sup> Puckle & Richd Thomas their several Claims Interfering Application

hath been made to us that the location of the said Lands should be regulated

and that the said Land laid out to Ingelo if admitted to be there among the

said Welch Settlers should be laid Uniform with the lands adjacent: These are

therefore to Authorize and Require thee forthwith in the first place to Survey and

lay out to the sd Nathan Puckle in right of ye sd Ingelo the sd quantity of Six

hundred Acres in the said place And in ye same where it now is, only turning

the length breadthwise and making the Boundaries uniform with the Adjacent Lands and

make Returns thereof together with the rest of the land claimed by ye sd Richd Thomas or his Assigns

into the General Surveyors Office where this warrant is to remain & a Copy to be deliv'd to thee cer-
