


Pensilvania 55:



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of William Pusey of the county of Chester that we would Grant him to take up five Hundred Acres of Land in this Province for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietor's use Fifty pounds for the whole and the usual Yearly Quitrent of one shilling Sterling for every Hundred Acres. These are to authorize & require thee to survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said William Pusey according to the method of Townships appointed the said quantity of Five Hundred acres of Land within the said Province that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make a Returne thereof into the Secretary's, which Survey in case the said William Pusey fulfill the above agreement within three months after Location shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made or this warrant ever Granted Given under our hands and seal of the Province at Philadelphia the fifth day of the ninth Month Anno Dni 1714.
