Surveyed for Joseph phips 200 acres of Land Lieng in the township  
of Concord begining at a marked post being a corner mark of robert  
Adams Land and runing along the sd Adams line of marked <sup>trees</sup> 480 perch  
w. s. w. to a marked red oak then N. N. W. 67 perch to a marked red oak  
from thence runing E. N. E. 480 perch along w<sup>th</sup> Collets line of marked  
trees to a marked post standing by the road and ~~runing~~ from thence run-  
ing <sup>67 perch</sup> S. S. E. along the sd road to the first menched post.
