At the Request of John Packer of the County of Chester that we would  
 Grant him to take up the Quantity of four hundred Eighty four Acres of Land  
 the Remainder of One Thousand acres the original purchase made of the  
 late Proprietor by John Boyce of Luckington in ye County of Wiltshire by Deeds of  
 Lease & Release dated the 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> days of October anno 1681 the Right  
 whereof by Sundry Metic Conveyances being now vested in the said John Packer  
 These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in  
 Right of the aforesaid Purchase According to the Method of Townships ap-  
 pointed the said remaining quantity of four hundred eighty four acres of  
 land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated  
 by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office in  
 Order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and the Lesser  
 Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of December Anno Domini 1726.
