At ye Request of Caleb Pusey, yt I would grant him to take up a piece of Ground for ye use of ye mill at Chester, over ag^t y^e Mill in y^e County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him Tenⁿ Acres of Land for ye use of y^e sd Mill, in ye place aforesaid, where not already taken up & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 25th of ye 4th mo. 1684.
