At ye Request of Caleb Pusey, Purchaser late of fifty Acres, yt I would grant him to take up ye sd 50 Acres joyning to one hundred & fifty acres he hath a warrant for, in ye New Township to be layd out betwixt Darby Creek & Crum Creek in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him ye sd Number of Acres adjoyning to ye former 150 in ye sd County & Township, if not taken up, according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadelphia ye 14th of ye 12th mo. 1683.
