



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Commissioners of property dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April last past I Resurvey'd to Joseph Pennock a certain Tract of Land situate in the Township of Marlborough in the County of Chester.

Beginning at a corner marked black Oak standing in Marlborough Street being a corner of Henry Treweller's Land thence East along the sd Street one hundred and Seventy perches to a post at a corner of Robt. Pyle's Land thence North by the Land of the sd Robt. Pyle three hundred Ninety & six perches to a post in a Line of John Bennett's Land thence west by the Land of the sd John Bennett one hundred & Seventy perches to a post at a corner of John Simcock's Land thence South by ye Land of the sd John Simcock the Land of Walter Cock and Robt Jones and the Land of the sd Henry Treweller three hundred Ninety Six perches to the place of beginning containing four hundred and twenty acres.

This Tract was first laid out for 300 as, and now the Prop<sup>r</sup> has been pleas'd to Grant the over Resurvey'd the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1725. plus in lieu of the Allowance due on 2050 acres for which he had none made and a Patent thereupon *Isaac Taylor* ordered.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighth day of September, 1909.
