er viz begining at a corner marked white oak saplin, standing in ye line of EV-  
an Lewis Thence by ye sd Lewis's land, David Howell's land and John Earl's land,  
west 17° south 250 perches to a corner post, thence by a line of marked trees and  
by vacant Land north north west 35 perches and one fourth part of a perch to  
a corner post, thence by a line of marked trees and by vacant Land East 17°  
north 250 perches to a corner maked black oak saplin, thenc by a line of marked  
Trees and by vacant Land south south East 35 perches and 1/4 of a perch to ye  
place of beginning Containing 55 acres of Land.
