


FORM NO 1.



In pursuance of a contract with the members of the Board of Property of the State of Penn^s dated Nov^r 1st 1827 &c the Authority therein stated the above tract of land was Surveyed & drafted &c by virtue of Appn. No 2128 granted to William Pimm by the proprietary Government Ap^r 3^d 1769, Containing three Hundred thirty five acres Sixty four perches & Alls situate chiefly in Versailles Township Allegheny County.
