At y^e request of Thomas Rudyard purchaser of five thousand
acres yt I would grant him to take up his lotts in ye city both in ye front & high
street & proportion of land wthin ye Liberties. These are to will & require thee
forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd. lotts where they
fell & proportion of land wthin ye Liberties, and make returns thereof into
my secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia y^e 6th of ye 4th m^o 1684.
