Upon an agreement made with Morgan Jones of Concord for ffour hundred Acres of Land on or near the branches of Octopus Creek in the County of Chester for which he is to pay to the Propriet^rs use fforty Pounds Money of Pensilvania for the whole and y^e yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for each hundred Acres These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the said Morgan Jones at the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of ffour hundred Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretary's Office which Survey in case the said Morgan fulfill the above agreemt by paying the said fforty pounds within one year after the date hereof and nine Months interest for the same shall be valid otherwise the same shall is to be Void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant at all Granted Given under our hands & Seal of the Province at Philad^ay first day of y^e first Mo^t A D 1717
