At the Request of Isaac Jeffevre That We would Grant him to take up three hundred Acres of Land or more adjoyning to the Settlement made by the Palatins towards Contestogoe for which he hath Agreed to ~~pay~~ immediately after Survey ten pounds for each hundred acres & so proportionably and One shilling sterlinc p hundred for a Yearly Quittt These are to Authorize thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the sd Isaac Jeffevre according to the Method of Townships the said quantity of three hundred Acres or more if he shall desire it in y^e said place where vacant and not yet survey'd nor taken up nor seated by the Indians. and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Which said Survey in case the sd Isaac comply with the said agreement in paying ~~of~~ the sd Consideration Money shall be valid, otherwise shall be void as if the same had never been made nor this Warr^t ever Granted Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^a the 15th day of the 4th Month AD 1713
