


By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary and Governoour dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of 8<sup>r</sup> 1701 for Laying out unto Andrew Rudman for the use of himself and Several of the Swedes ten thousand acres of <sup>Land</sup>. There is Survey'd unto Matthias Holston in part of the said ten Thousand acres Nine hundred acres of land Situate on the East side of Schuylkil in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at <sup>o</sup> stake By the River Schuylkil at the Corner of Peter Boott's land ~~Thence~~ Thence by the line of the said Boott's land North twenty deg<sup>e</sup> east one thousand two hundred and ten perches to a post Then by Vacant Land East south east one hundred twenty two perches a half to a post Then by the line of Peter Cocks Land south twenty degrees West one thousand one hundred and thirty five perches to the River Schuylkil Then up the same to the place of the Beginning Survey'd the 28<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>mo</sup> 1704
