a Lott in a Street on Delaware, sett out for Purchasers of y<sup>e</sup> like Quantity  
of Acres and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at  
Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> of Febr<sup>ry</sup> 1683.
