 the Ground at the Corner of Jn<sup>o</sup> Roberts his Land from thence by a line  
 of Marked trees and the s<sup>d</sup> Roberts's Land west South west two hundred

 land from thence north north west two hundred and ten perches to a  
 Stake in the line of Robert Loyd's land Then by the said land East  
 North east one hundred and ninety two per: to a Stake by a black oak  
 Sapling in a line of Christopher Pennocks Land Then by the same South
