



By ye Commission ^{is} impowered to grant Lotts & land in the Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereto belonging.

At ye request of John Test, yt we would grant him to take up a lott in ye City as near Delaware— as may be. These are in ye Proprietarys name to will & require thence forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him a Lott to ye Westward of John Bolt on ye back of High Street, he fencing it in & building upon ye same wthin six months after ye date of survey according to regulation, & make returns thereof into ye Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 13th $\frac{11}{12}$ mo. 1684.
