 of ground. On the bank of Shuyl(obl.) on Society Hill. Containing in breadth one hundred foot
 and in Length two hundred & fifty foot bounded to ye northward w^t vaccant Lotts East
 ward with the River Delaware at ye said extent of two hundred and fifty foot southw^d w^t
 Rich^d Walls Lott and to ye westw^d w^t the new Street and was accordingly entred into
 the Surv^r Gen^{ll} office the _____ of the _____ Month _____
