


## Memorandum.

50<sup>o</sup> being pt of 100<sup>o</sup> beginning at a Chestnut standing at a corner of the residue of the sd 100<sup>o</sup> thence by Vacant S.S.E 58 perches to a post thence W.S.W. 148 perches to the River Skoolkill thence up the several courses thereof about 62 perches &  $\frac{1}{4}$  to a corner Post being another corner of the residue of the sd tract now belonging to Andrew Robins on thence by the same N.E by E. half a point eastly 194 perches to the place of beginning. 80<sup>oo</sup><sup>es</sup> beginning at a small saplin markt being a corner tree of W<sup>m</sup> Palmers land thence N.W 90 perches by Vacant land to a stake in the line of Richard Vickeris's land. thence by the same W.S.W 96 perches, thence N.N.W 39 perches ~~vacant land~~ to a stake in Benj<sup>a</sup> Morgan's line, thence by the said line W.S.W 70 perches &  $\frac{1}{2}$  thence by Vacant land & a line of markt trees S.S.E 123 perches to a post in the said Palmers line thence by the same E.N.E 116  $\frac{1}{2}$  perches to the place of beginning. To pay a quit rent proportionable to one English shilling for a 1000<sup>o</sup> on the 1<sup>st</sup> of March yearly forever. Walter L. H.
