rent five hundred acres of land in ye County of Philadelphia and being Recom-
mended by Capt Thomas Holme, and likewise assured us that he expects three
Familys out of Ireland to seat the same.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thre^e forthwith
to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him the said number of acres in ye a-
foresaid County where not already taken up according to ye method of town-
ships appoynted by the Gover^t. he seating upon ye same the three Family's
abovementioned and improving the same according within one whole year
after the date of survey and make returne hereof to the Sec^ry's office. Dated
at Philadelphia ye 25 of ye 11 month 1685.
