surveyd unto him ye said number of acres on Skunkill in ye first town-  
ship to be laid out after ye date hereof, and make returns thereof into  
my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 21<sup>st</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1770. 1683.
