At ye request of Christopher Taylor, yt I would grant him to take up his Proportion of land within ye Liberties of ye City answerable to his Purchase of five Thousand acres. These are to will & require thence forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him his Proportion on Delaware side w<sup>th</sup>in ye bounds thereof and make returns of it into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 29<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo. 1684.
