At ye request of Catharine Thomas Purchaser of one thousand two hundred & fifty acres, yt wee would grant her to take up the Lott in High street proportionable: These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto her a lott in ye sd street where it fells to falling it in & building upon ye same w<sup>th</sup>in one year from ye date of survey, & make returns thereof into ye secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia  
ye 16<sup>th</sup> of ye 7<sup>th</sup> mo. 1684.
