By virtue of a warrant from ye Com^{ee} impowred to grant Lots and Lands to Purchas^{ee} and rent^{es} ~~to People~~ in this Province and Territories there unto belonging, bearing date ye 21st of ye 5th moneth 1685 I here by certifie in ye Proprietary and Govern^{ee} Secretaryes office that(h) I have caused to be surveyed and laid out ye R.7th of ye 5th moneth 1685 unto Robert Tailer Purchas^r of (one Thousand acres of land) his proportion of land in ye Liberties of ye City of Philadelphia. Begining at a corn^e marked post standing by ye land belonging unto Robert Turner from thence W.S.W. by ye said land 113 perches to a corn^e marked post standing by ye land belong(h) unto Samuell Carpenter from thence N.N.W. by ye said land 23 perches to a corn^e marked post from thence east northeast by a line of marked trees 113 perches to a corn^e marked post thence south south east by a line of marked trees 23 perches to ye first mentioned place of begining. Containing and laid out as above, for sixteen acres of land, and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia ye 10th of ye 6th mo (861)
