Surveyed for Joseph Allabone 250 acres and Robert Bourrough 50 acres being all 300 acres together not divided lying on the southside of Ridly Creek beginning at a black walnut by the sd Creek side being the corner tree of Elizabeth Jarvis and running up the sd Jarvis line of marked trees S. W. b. N. 330 percht to a marked white oak from thence N. W. b. N. 150 percht to a marked white oak from thence N. E. b. E. 370 percht to a marked hickrey standing by Ridly Creek and from thence down the Creek on several courses to the first (obliterated) (ob.l.)
