These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee fourthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye said number of acres in manner aforesaid where not already taken up by seating and improving the same within six months after ye date of survey and make returne hereof to ye Secretarys office dated at Philadelphia ye 10th 9th 1685.
