



Pursuant to a warrant to me directed by Edward Pennington surveyor General dated the 13 day of the 7th month 1700 laid out to Mary and Alice Hirnd Administratrices on the estate of John Atkison joint pur-
hasser with Christopher Atkison for the use of the children of the said John Atkison. Beginning at an oake then northwest three hundred ~~six~~^{ty nine} perchas
by land left for a road to a black oake then southwest two hundred and
seventeen perchas by vacant land to a post and a heape of stones then
southeast three hundreded sixty nine perchas by vacant land to a heape
of stones and an oake marked neare the corr Then by vacant land
north east two hundred and seventeen perchas to the place of Begin-
ning. Containing five hundreded acres of land surveyed and certified
under my hand the 9th day of the 3 month 1701.
