

By virtue of a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the seal of the Province dated the 26th day of ye 11th month 1703 for laying out unto Benjⁿ Furlow 50 acres of land on the west side of Schuylkill —

Survey'd and laid out unto Benjamin Furlow the 22nd of ye first month 1703. a tract of land on the west side of ~~Schuykill~~ Schuylkill in the Liberties of the City Philadelphia beginning at a stake in the line of Haverford township from thence west south west ninety perches to a second stake near the mill Creek There by the several Courses ^{thereof} south 39 deg east forty per. south 12 deg east fifty two perches to a white oak sapling marked by the said Creek then east north east ninety four per to a stake in the line of Will Roberts land then by the said land north north west ninety per. to the beginning containing fifty acres survey'd by David Powel & returned into ye Gen^l Surveyor's office ye 5th ^{2 mo. 1703.} Revised in the said office
