At ye request of Benjamin Furley, Purchaser of five thousand acres, yt wee would grant him to take up one thousand acres of land thereof in ye County of Bucks. These are therefore in ye Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye aforesd County, where not already taken up, according to ye method of townships appointed by the Govern^c by seating & improving ye same within six moneths from ye date of survey and make returns thereof unto ye Govern^c Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th 10th m^o 1684.
