 Caleb Pusey 250 Acres, John Pusey 250, Jn<sup>th</sup> Hicks 250 Acres &  
 Robt Hart 250 Acres. yt I would grant him to take up their several  
 Proportions of Land w<sup>th</sup>in ye Liberties of ye City on yeside of Dela-  
 ware w<sup>th</sup> other Purchasers. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup>  
 to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him so much Land w<sup>th</sup>in yesd  
 Liberties joyning together as is yedue Proportion on yt side for somuch  
 Purchase where not already taken up & make returns thereof into  
 my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 14<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo  
 1683.
