

*Pensylvania 55.**By the Commissioners of Property*

*At the Request of Henry Evans of the City of Philadelphia That we would Grant him to take up & inclose one Square of Ground between Mulberry Street & Sassafras Street and between the eighth & ninth Streets from Delaware and that he may hold the same for the space of one & Twenty Years next ensuing the date hereof for which he agrees to pay to the use of the Prop<sup>r</sup>y. or Trustees of the Province forty Shillings Sterling Money of Great Britain Yearly during the said Term and at the expiration thereof to deliver up and Surrender the Same under a good fence & well improved These are to Authorize and require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the Said Henry Evans in the place aforesaid the said Square of Ground to be by him held under y<sup>e</sup> Said Yearly rent of forty Shillings Sterling which in case the said Henry Evans yearly fulfill & pay. Then this Survey shall be for the said Term Valid otherwise the same is to be Void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of the first Month Anno Din 1719<sub>20</sub>*
