

At the Request of Stephen Evans of the Township of Radnor that we would grant him a Resurvey on two hundred and fifty acres of land laid out in the said Township within the Welch Tract ^{part} by Vertue of a General Warrt from the Proprietary bearing date the 13th of the first month ¹⁶⁸⁴ in right of David James mean purchaser of one hundred Acres under Richd Davies first purchaser of 5000 Acres and the remainder by Vertue of a Warrt from the Comm^{rs} & in right of a purchase made by David Meredith of the Prop^r in this Province : These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Stephen Evans the said number of two hundred and fifty Acres of Land in his possession now being in the place aforesaid and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd. to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy return into his Office.
