


Pensylvania

For the better regulating of former erroneous surveys and discovering such mistakes as have been in their Returns of Lands laid out in several parts of the County of Chester. These are to Authorize and Require thee forthwith to examine and try all the old Lines that may reasonably be suspected to be erroneous as aforesaid in all the Several tracts not yet resurvey'd in the Townships of Aston, Thornbury, Edgemont, Westown and Ridley in the County aforesaid and as near as may be to make general Returns of the said Townships in one or more Plots or particular as thou shalt hereafter be directed into the general Surveyor's Office at Philadia where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 27<sup>th</sup> of the 2d Month 1703.
