



Pursuant to a warrant from the Commissioners of Property Dated the twenty sixth Day of March 1733 Surveyd to James Steel in right of — a certain Tract of land situate abt. ^{two}₁ Miles above the German Tract in the County of Philad^e begining at a post in the line of a tract of land laid out for Richd Morrey thence by Vact Land North East three hundred & sixteen perches to a post thence by Vact Land North west two Hundred sixty five perches to a post thence by Vact Land South west three hundred & sixteen perches to a post thence by Vact Land south east two hundred sixty five perches to the place of begining Containing four hundred ninety two acres with Allowance of six p cent. Surveyd April 13th 1733.
