It is part of the Homble the Proprietary Richard Penn Esquire his Manor of Andulthea. The whole was surveyed in one Tract by order of the Proprietaries in the year 1741 for Christopher Urick who assigned part thereof in Tulpehockon Township to Michael Azah.
