These are to authorize and require thee forthwith to survey and lay out to our Good Friend Andrew Hamilton of the City of Philadelphia Gent one Square of Ground within the said City To be holden of us our Heirs & Successors unto the said Andrew Hamilton his Executors and Administrators for the Term of one and Twenty years next ensuing the date hereof under the yearly Quittance of one shilling Sterling for the same and make returne of the survey of the said Square into the Secretarys Office for which this shall be thy sufficient warrant Given under my hand and the lesser Seal of our Province at Philadelphia the 22<sup>d</sup> day of the fourth month (June) Anno. 1733.
