

In pursuance of a warrant from the Commissioners of Property
to me directed bearing date the 5th day of August in the year 1719
I have surveyed and laid out the 23^d day of April 1720 unto Andrew
Hamilton of the City of Philadelphia Gent. a certain piece of vacant
Ground in the said City Bounded southward with a Lot formerly
surveyed to John Tibby on the west ^{with} a piece of Ground late Joseph
Walker's deceased on the North with the Lower End of the Chestnut
Street Lot late Richard Woodworthis now in the Tenure of the said And-
rew Hamilton being in Length from north to south forty three foot
and in Breadth from east to west nineteen foot Returned into the
Secretary's office this 29th day of April 1720.
