

In pursuance of warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 5th day of the sixth month 1719 I have surveyd and set out unto Andrew Hamilton of the City of Philadelphia Gent. a certain piece of vacant Ground in the said City Bounded southward with a Lot formerly surveyd (at the extent of 212 from Walnut str^t) to John Tibby, on the west with a piece of Ground late Joseph Walker's deceased on the North with the lower end of the Chesnut street Lot Late Richd Woodworth's ^{now} in the Tenure of the said Andrew Hamilton being in Length from north to south forty three foot and Breadth from east to West nineteen foot Surveyd the twenty third day of April 1720 and Returned into the Secretarys Office the 29th of the same month & year.
