

Pennsylvania ss.

By virtue of a General warrant to me directed bearing date the 25th day of November 1748. I have caused to be surveyed on the 8th day of November 1749 for the use of the Honourable the Proprietaries a certain Tract of land situate on Schuylkill River beyond the Blue Mountains ^{formerly} in the County of Lancaster now in the County of Berks, Beginning at a post standing on the west side of the said River and from thence extending by vacant land the eight courses and distances next following vizt south eighty eight degrees west forty six perches to a marked white oak, south ten degrees west two hundred and twenty eight Perches to a post. South fifty five degrees east one hundred and eighty seven perches and a half to a marked Spanish oak, south ten deg^s East fifty perches to a marked white oak, north eighty degrees east fifty seven perches to a marked white oak south fifty seven degrees east eighty perches to a marked white oak south sixty seven degrees and a half east sixty four perches to a marked black oak, and south eighty eight degrees east fourteen perches to the east side of the said Schuylkill River, thence down the same on the several courses thereof to a stone, thence by vacant land the nine courses and distances next following vizt: South fifty degrees west sixty nine perches to a small Hickery marked north seventy five degrees west twenty nine perches and a half to a marked Spanish oak. North twenty six degrees and a half west sixteen perches, ~~and~~ north twenty degrees west forty perches, North twenty four degrees west fifty four perches, North three degrees and a half east eighteen perches. North eighteen degrees and a half east twenty four perches. North twenty degrees and a half west forty one perches to a marked Hickery, and south sixty degrees west, crossing the said Schuylkill River, twenty seven perches to the west side thereof thence up the said River on the several courses thereof to the place of Beginning containing six hundred and forty six acres and the usual allowance of six acres & Cent for roads &c^s Returned into the Secretarys Office the 11th day of Dec^r 1754.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-eighth day of March 1910.
