 the first Month 1684 and in right of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Rowlands Purchase under Richard Davies These  
 are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the s<sup>d</sup> Rowland Ellis the s<sup>d</sup> five hundred Acres of  
 Land in Meirion and the s<sup>d</sup> four hundred and eighty three Acres in Goshen laid out as afores<sup>d</sup>  
 and make Returns thereof into the Genl Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr<sup>t</sup>  
 is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee attested by the Secretary who is also to  
 take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands & y<sup>e</sup> Seal of the  
 Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701.


