At the Request of James Logatt That we would Grant him to take up ~~Eighty~~ Seventy Acres of Land remaining untaken up of two hundred and fifty Acres of Original Purchase of Edw^d Edwards of the County of Wilts with the whole Right to which Purchase y^s James appears to be now invested As also that we would grant him to take ~~up~~ the Proportion of Liberty Land and City Lot^t appurtenant to the s^d Purchase These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd to the s^d James Logatt adjoining to his other Land granted to be taken up the s^d quantity of ~~eighty~~ Seventy Acres of Land with his Proportion of Liberty Land and Town Lot^t appurtenant to y^e s^d Purchase where Vacant and not conceal'd, and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands & Seal of the s^d Province at Philad^{ia} the fourteenth day of October Anno Domi. 1708
