

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Propriator dated the 28 day of May 1733 and by .an order from Jacob Taylor to me derected I have Surveyed this Tract of Land to Adam Harker for an old Right which he bought Begining at a Whit Oak marked for a corner standing in the Line of Richard Hills Land then North west two houndred and twelve Pearches to a Post by the said Hills Land then South west two Hundred Ninty Eight Pearches by-Marpols Land and other Lands to a Post then South East two houndred and twelve Pearches by Jenken Willian Land to a Smal Hickry then North East two houndred and Ninty Eight Pearches by vacand Land to the place of begining Containing three Houndred Seventy five acres with usal alowance for Roads Survueyed in the County of Buoks near Hill Township the 20 of the 4 month 1733
