Whereas in and by Deeds of Lease and Release bearing date the twenty Second
 & twenty third days of the Month of May Anno Domini 1724 We Granted unto James
 Logan of Our said Province Merch^t [together with other Lands] a Certain Tract
 Situate ^{on} Schecassalutigoe Creek in the County now called Lancaster Supposed there
 to Contain One Thousand three Hundred Acres with an addition to be made unto
 the same, Now at the Request of the said James Logan These are to Authorize
 and Require thee to Presurvey or cause to be Presurveyd unto him the said James
 Logan the said Tract of Land and make Return of the same [with an addition to
 contain in the whole One thousand four hundred Acres] into Our Secretarys Office
 in order for further Confirmation and for which this shall be thy Sufficient Warr.
 Given Under my Hand and the Lesser Seal of Our Province at Philadelphia this
 Second day of Septem^r Anno Domini 1734.
