

Pursuant to a War^t from y^e Commiss^rs of Prop^ty directed unto Me bearing Date y^e 29 day of y^e 7th m^o Last: I do hereby Certify y^t I have Reasurvayd unto John Humphrys a Certaine tract of Land in y^e County of Philadelphia in y^e Township Gwynedd beginn^g at a stak set in y^e ground in a Line of Joseph ffishers Land from thence by y^e said Line of marked trees South East: 257 perches to a stak set in the ground from thence by a Line of marked trees deviding it from Robert Evans Land ~~East~~: West 47 degrees South 361 perch to a stak set in y^e ground thence by a Line of Marked trees deviding it from Edward ffoulke^s Land North 47 degrees West: 260 perches to a stak set in a Line of Owen ap Evans Land from thence by a Line of Marked trees & y^e same Land East 47 degrees North 351 perches to y^e place of beginn^g Containing 561 acres of Land and is according to y^e bounds above described Return'd into y^e Generall Survey^rs Office at Philadelphia y^e 21st day of y^e 10 m^o 1702
