


Pursuant to a warrant from the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of Property dated the 22<sup>d</sup> of March 1690 there was surveyd and sett out on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the same month and year unto several persons Lotts of ground on the bank of Delaware above and near to the City Philadelphia of which said Lotts there was one appropriated to Francis Rawls Bounded on the west with the Great Road or the front Street of y<sup>e</sup> said City continued on the north by Jn<sup>o</sup> Goodson's Lot on the east by Delaware River and on the South by Thomas Lanston's Lott Being in breadth forty-foot and in length two hundred and fifty foot.

Returned into the Secretary's Office the 22<sup>d</sup> of the third month in the year 1717.
