Survey'd and laid out the 13th day of September 1704 unto Charles Read a Lott in the City Philadelphia (being part of ye Front Lott called Lactitias Lot) bounded on the east with ye thirty-six foot ally on the north with the ends of the High street lotts on the west with ye ends of the second street Lotts

Being in length from east to west eighty foot and in breadth from north to softh twenty four foot and a half.
