At ye Request of Richard Russell y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to take up a Lott on ye other side of Shulkill in ye front facing ye City of Philadelphia: These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>t</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in ye said place y<sup>e</sup> usual <sup>sixty-foot</sup> front and ~~breadth~~<sup>length</sup> and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 25<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> 2d mo<sup>o</sup> 1684.
